Additionally, the campus is home to a upcoming state-of-the-art multispecialty hospital which will provide 1,800 beds high-quality healthcare services to the community in and around the region, along with two functional multispecialty hospitals with 450+ Bed (Gorakhnath Chikitsalaya) and 200 Bed (Mahayogi Gorakhnath Chikitsalaya) both at Gorakhpur.

Job Requirement: Mahayogi Gorakhnath University, Gorakhpur invites applications for the position of **Optometrist** to provide eye care services including vision assessment, refraction, and assistance in ophthalmic diagnostics. The role demands professional knowledge in optometry, patient-centric service, and collaboration with clinical teams to ensure quality eye care delivery.

Job Description: The following are the job roles and description of the duties:

- Perform refraction and retinoscopy in adults and children (including cycloplegic refraction).
- Diagnose and manage refractive errors: myopia, hyperopia, astigmatism and presbyopia.
- Conduct visual acuity tests and use autorefractor.
- Prescribe and dispense spectacles and contact lenses.
- Perform and guide patients on orthoptic exercises for conditions like convergence insufficiency, amblyopia and eye strain.
- Assist in eye screening camps and patient counselling.
- Maintain proper patient records and coordinate with ophthalmologists.

Essential Qualification: Bachelor's Degree in Optometry (B. Optometry) from a recognized institution & Proficiency in operating ophthalmic diagnostic machines.

Desirable Qualification: Certification in low vision management or pediatric optometry will be an added advantage.

Experience: Minimum 1 year of clinical or academic experience preferred. However, freshers may also apply.
